

LEGAL NOTICE

The Area Agency on Aging for Lincolnland, Inc., is accepting Letters of Intent to apply for funding through the Older Americans Act and Illinois General Revenue Funds for Fiscal Year 2012, October 1, 2011, through September 30, 2012. Successful applicants may be offered the opportunity to extend funding through up to two (up to five for certain programs) additional fiscal years on a non-competitive basis.

Applicants must be private not-for-profit corporations, local units of government, or profit-making corporations serving the Illinois Counties of Cass, Christian, Greene, Jersey, Logan, Macoupin, Mason, Menard, Montgomery, Morgan, Sangamon, or Scott. Prior approval from the Illinois Department on Aging must be received by the Area Agency before funding a profit-making corporation.

Applications will be accepted from only those agencies submitting a Letter of Intent by the deadline stated below.

Community Based services to be funded: Title III-B Information and Assistance, Title III-B Legal Assistance, Title III-D Routine Health Screening and Medication Management.

Caregiver Support (Title III E) services: Access Assistance, Counseling, In-Home Respite, Legal Assistance.

Regional Long Term Care Ombudsman Program

Services include: investigative services, regular presence in long term care facilities, consultation and community education, systems advocacy, and resident and family support, in accordance with the Illinois Department on Aging rules as set forth in Ill. Adm. Code Title 89, CH II Part 270.100 and the Program Standards.

Elder Abuse and Neglect Program

Program operates on State Fiscal Year, July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2012.

Applications will be available for funding only in the counties of Logan, Mason, Menard, and Sangamon.
