

## LEGAL NOTICE

The Area Agency on Aging for Lincolnland, Inc. is accepting Letters of Intent to apply for funding under Title III of the Older Americans Act and Illinois General Revenue Funds for Fiscal Year 2010, beginning October 1, 2009 and ending September 30, 2010. Successful applicants may be offered the opportunity to extend funding through one to two additional fiscal years on a non-competitive basis. Letters of Intent must specify counties and services for which the agency intends to apply.

Applicant agencies must be private not-for-profit corporations, local units of government, or profit-making corporations serving the Illinois Counties of Cass, Christian, Greene, Jersey, Logan, Macoupin, Mason, Menard, Montgomery, Morgan, Sangamon, or Scott. Prior approval from the Illinois Department on Aging must be received by the Area Agency before funding a profit-making corporation. Applications will be accepted from only those agencies submitting a Letter of Intent prior to the deadline. Service to be funded is:
